

How to Submit Your 2020-2021 Virtual FVYJ Audition



1. Register for an audition at <https://forms.gle/Lga9e6ZDwghJpCBW9>

2. Check the audition requirements!
 - Visit http://fvyouthjazz.org/index_files/Registration.htm to see the requirements for your ensemble and instrument.
 - NO sight-reading will be required for virtual auditions.
 - Your recording should be a video recording of you performing the following straight through (no edits):
 - Scales
 - Solo piece #1 (only 2 minutes)
 - Solo piece #2 (only 2 minutes)
 - Before you record, keep in mind the following:
 - We should be able to see you, waist-up, and the entirety of your instrument and hands.
 - Dress for a virtual audition the same way you would an in-person audition.

3. Video Record your audition on your device.
 - An i-Phone, i-Pad, or Android phone/tablet has sufficient built-in video and audio technology to record quality musical performance.
 - If you choose to use a built-in webcam on a computer, record and check the highest and loudest part of your audition repertoire to make sure it records the audio properly.
 - USB microphones can in-expensively be purchased on Amazon.com and do wonders to enhance audio quality of musical performances.
 - ***You will not be penalized for the quality of your recording.*** Use the resources that are readily available to you. Please reach out to auditions@fvyouthorchestra.org if you have concerns or questions.

4. Submit your video audition to audition@fvyouthjazz.org.
